Mount Tomah Botanic Garden is the cool-climate garden of the Botanic Gardens Trust. It covers 28 hectares on the summit of a basalt-capped peak 1000 metres above sea level in the world heritage listed Greater Blue Mountains. The theme of this garden emphasises coolclimate plants from around the world, especially those from the southern hemisphere.

The Mount Tomah garden is one of the few botanic gardens where plants have been grouped according to their geographical origin.
